

## **CODE OF CONDUCT FOR PARENTS/ GUARDIANS**

- Encourage your child to learn the rules and play within them.
- Discourage unfair play and arguing with officials.
- Help your child to recognise good performance, not just results.
- Never force your child to take part in sport.
- Set a good example by recognising fair play and applauding the good performances of all.
- Never punish or belittle a child for losing or making mistakes.
- Publicly accept officials' judgements.
- Support your child's involvement and help them to enjoy their sport.
- Use correct and proper language at all times.
- Leave the coaching to the coaches
- Provide only encouragement and applause whilst your child's team is playing
- Respect the coaches decisions they are only human
- If you have an issue (unless urgent) please approach your coach at the next training session. Please refrain from texting your coach at midnight out of frustration/anger.

If a coach feels a guardian is not behaving as the above states they will follow the below procedure:

1. Individual will receive a verbal warning.
2. If behaviour continues coach will notify head coach or Chairman, a meeting and a written warning will be given.
3. If behaviour continues individual will be banned from attending any club event match/tournament/training/social
